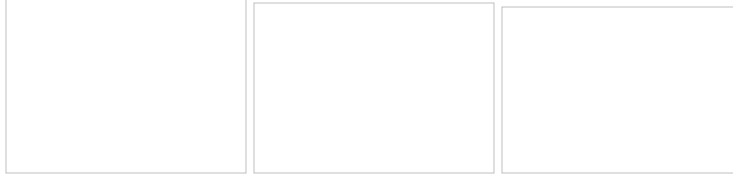

Blue and White Cross Stitch Quilt by Dorothy Short. Dorothy Short's mother, Daisy Miller Love Bauman, was a quilter in West Virginia. Short's daughter, Lois Bertram, quilted in New Mexico, as did Lois's daughter Jeannie. Lois's son, Ron Bertram, once designed a quilt for his mother to make.
